Report of an Awareness Program on “Basic Life Support and First Aid Training”

The Bhoj Reddy Engineering College for Women has organized an Awareness Program on “Basic Life Support and First Aid Training” for the first-year students of BTech program in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), Computer Science and Machine learning (CSM), Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE), Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE), and Information Technology (IT) students on 18 November 2023. Awareness Program was scheduled from 10:30 to 12:30 Hrs for I BTech CSE & IT students & 14:30 to 16:30 Hrs for I BTech CSM, ECE & EEE students. The speaker for the event was Dr. Mounika Mandalapu, Emergency Doctor, Apollo Hospital. The event was attended by Mr. Kavala Raja-CSR, South and MP region, Billion Hearts Beating Foundation by Apollo Hospital, Principal Dr J Madhavan, K. Sandhya, NCC Committee Incharge, staff and I CSE, CSM, ECE, EEE and IT students. The venue was Indoor Auditorium, Ramdev Block.

The awareness aimed to provide students with basic first aid training. The speaker, an Emergency doctor, shared her knowledge and experiences on how basic lifesaving and first aid procedures can save lives in emergency situations.

The event began with a warm welcome to the esteemed speaker by the college faculty and staff. The welcome speech was delivered by K. Divya Sree a student of I ECE A. Dr Mounika Mandalapu initiated the session for the morning slot, addressing the I BTech CSE & IT students. The program covered various aspects of first aid and life saving techniques.

In the afternoon session, Dr Mounika again took the stage to engage with the I BTech CSM, ECE & EEE students. The talks were tailored to teach the young students how to react in emergency situations and perform first aid and CPR. Dr Mounika practically demonstrated CPR using a mannequin and asked for various volunteers from the audience. Breathing and resuscitation for victims of heart and brain stroke were also shown by her.

Dr Mounika also gave a talk on overall female health, PCOD, Emergency treatment for burns and snake bites. Life saving techniques were discussed for many ordinary everyday accidents.
