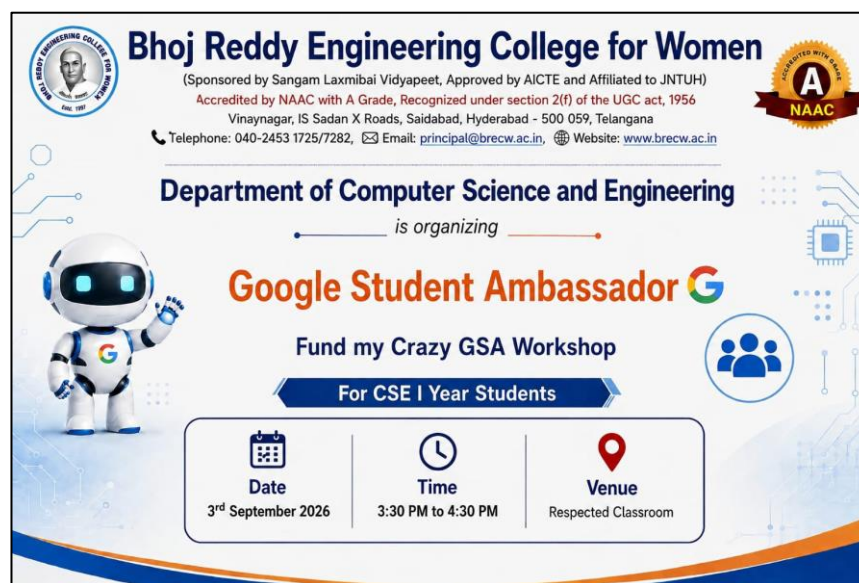


Figure 1: Banner

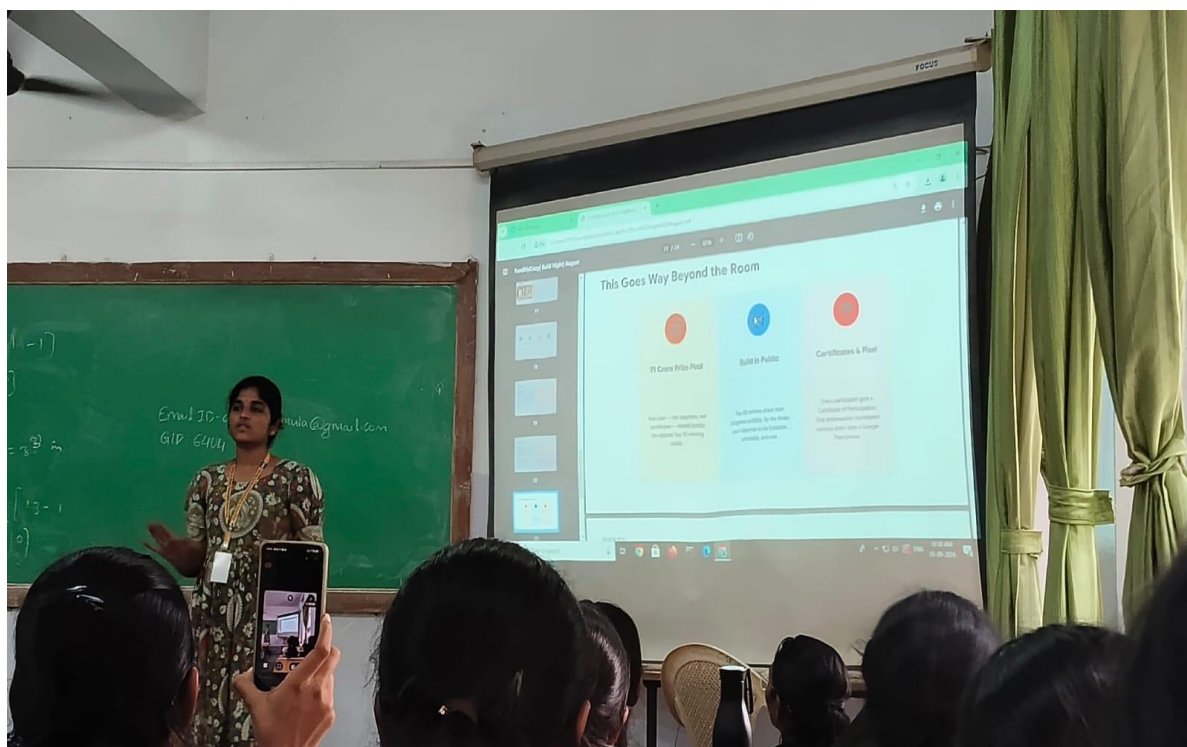

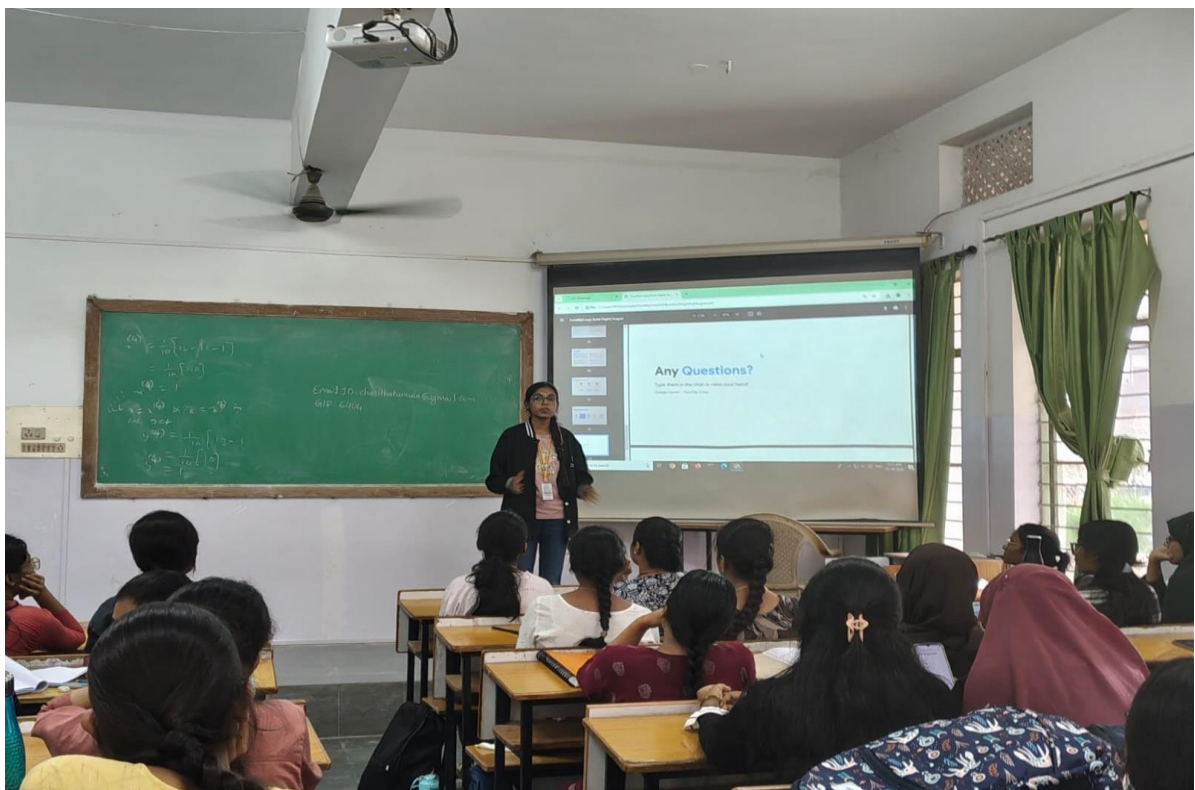

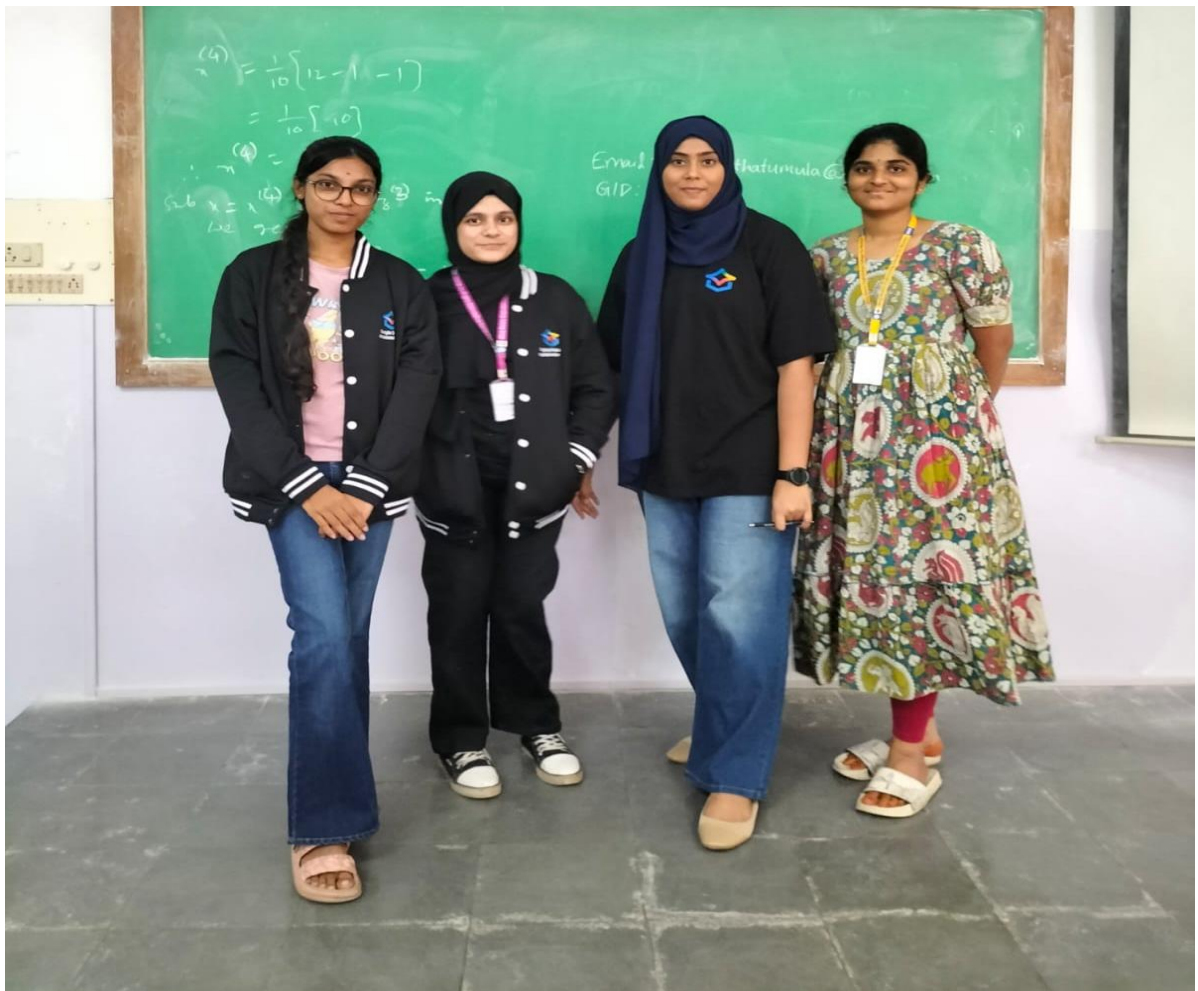


Figure 2: Google Ambassadors
