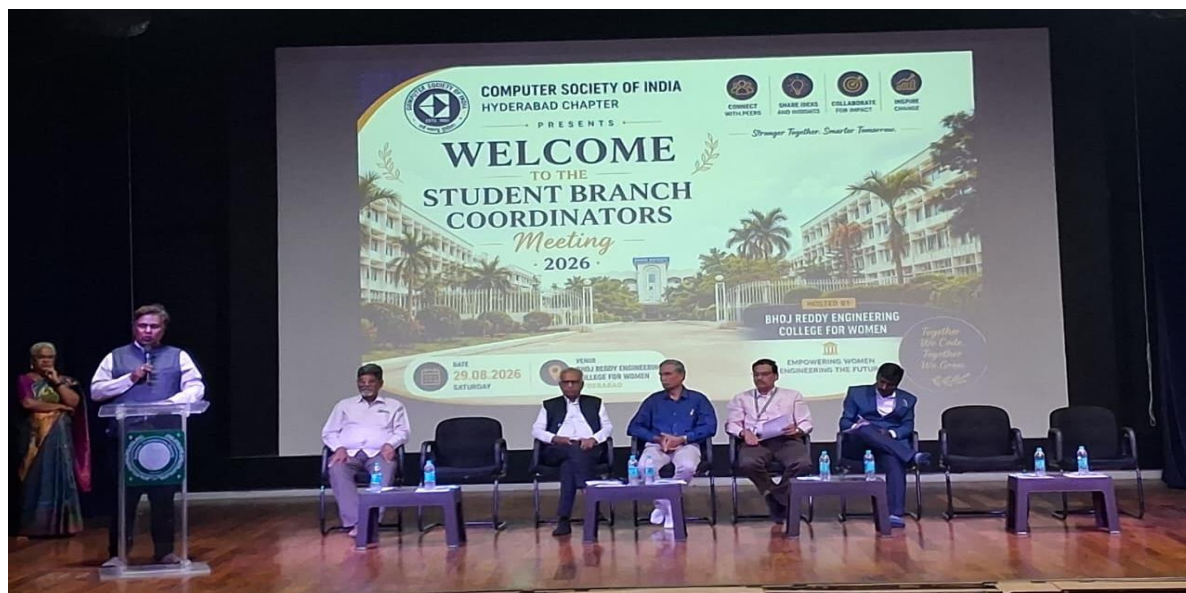


Figure 3: Dr C Srikanth, Secretary, CSI Hyderabad Chapter, addressing the participants.

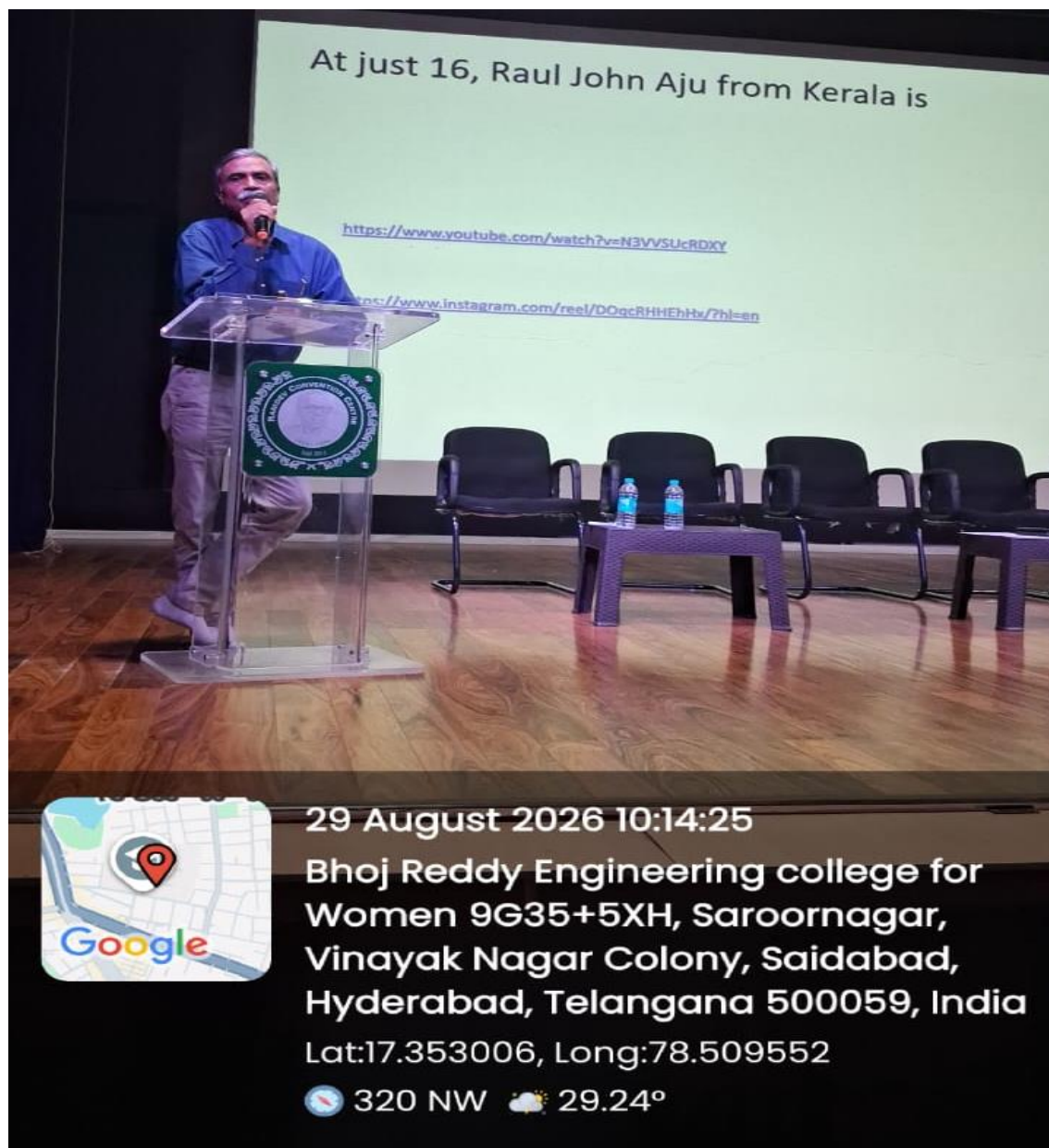


Figure 6: Prof A Rama Krishna Prasad, Chairman, CSI Hyderabad Chapter, delivering the Presidential Address.
