


Figure 13: Momento distribution to the guests

expertise and the active engagement of the audience contributed to the success of the event, leaving participants inspired and better equipped towards making the profession an area of choice amongst all sections of the society.




Figure 17: CSI Student Council Members with CSI delegates and staff
