- Cross-college teams are allowed.



General Guidelines:


1. ID card is mandatory

3. Selected candidates will be intimated through their respective E-mail
4. Detail of team members: Name, Year, Department, Institute, Contact number, Topic and its description should be mentioned in abstract. The description should be of minimum 120 words to maximum 150 words.
5. Candidates should send their abstract to our E mail: jjjnasa2024eee@gmail.com
6. Registration fee for IEEE , CSI and IETE members Rs 75/- and other participants Rs.100/-
7. Each team will consist of maximum 2 participants.
8. For registration and more information contact to the coordinators on or before **20th March 2024**.
9. Selected candidates will be intimated through their respective E mail by **22nd March 2024**.
10. For the selected abstracts , participants should prepare posters in A1 charts
11. Names and Institute name should appear on the backside of the poster.
12. All lettering and diagrams should be large enough to be read from a minimum of 2 feet.
13. The official language for the poster will be English.
14. All participants will receive participation certificates.
15. Marks will be based on theme, creativity, efforts taken, scientific content and presentation.


16. Decision of the judges/committee will be final.
