Report on Guest Lecture on PCOS by Dr. Poornima Durga from MOM IVF Hospital

On November 4, 2024, the NSS Committee of Bhoj Reddy Engineering College for Women, in collaboration with VIVO LIFE SCIENCES PVT LTD, hosted a guest lecture on Polycystic Ovary Syndrome (PCOS) by Dr Poornima Durga, MOM IVF Chief consultant. The lecture was held in the Ramdev Indoor Auditorium for II-year BTech. The timings were for 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM for CSE & IT and 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM for ECE.CSM & EEE. The lecture aimed to raise awareness about PCOS, its symptoms, causes, and treatment options among the students and faculty.



Lecture Highlights:

- Overview of PCOS: Dr. Poornima began the lecture by providing a comprehensive overview of PCOS, explaining that it is a common hormonal disorder affecting women of reproductive age2. She highlighted the key symptoms, including irregular menstrual cycles, excessive hair growth, weight gain, and acne.
- Causes and Risk Factors: The lecture delved into the potential causes and risk factors
 associated with PCOS, such as genetics, insulin resistance, and hormonal imbalances. Dr.
 Poornima emphasized the importance of early diagnosis and management to prevent
 long-term complications.
- 3. **Diagnosis and Treatment:** Dr. Poornima discussed the diagnostic methods for PCOS, including blood tests, ultrasounds, and physical examinations. She also outlined various treatment options, ranging from lifestyle changes and medications to surgical interventions in severe cases.
- 4. **Impact on Fertility:** A significant portion of the lecture was dedicated to the impact of PCOS on fertility. Dr. Poornima explained how PCOS can lead to ovulatory dysfunction and infertility, and she provided insights into fertility treatments and assisted reproductive technologies available at MOM IVF Hospital.
- 5. Lifestyle Management: The lecture concluded with practical advice on managing PCOS through lifestyle modifications, such as maintaining a healthy diet, regular exercise, and

stress management. Dr. Poornima encouraged students to adopt healthy habits to improve their overall well-being.



The guest lecture by Dr. Poornima was well-received by the audience, who found the information insightful and valuable. Dr. Poornima was felicitated by Dr. Seshu Bhavani at the end of the session. The session concluded with a Q&A segment, where students had the opportunity to ask questions and clarify their doubts. The lecture was a significant step towards raising awareness about PCOS and promoting health education among the students of Bhoj Reddy Engineering College.
